IMPORTANT PARKING INFORMATION

We suggest that you enter Washington Hebrew Congregation via the main doors facing Macomb Street NW. There is also a door facing the synagogue's parking lot, but that lot will *not* be available for use by the general public nor performers on concert night. We have arranged for three satellite parking locations—two free, one paid. All will be served by a free orange and green Old Town Trolley shuttle to and back from the synagogue.

FREE Lots: National United Methodist Church, 3401 Nebraska Avenue NW (space is limited! Arrive early. Board the trolley shuttle at the Metro bus shelter on New Mexico Avenue NW starting at 6 pm.) or Annunciation Catholic Church, 3125 39th Street NW (intended primarily for performing groups & their families.)

PAID Lot at Cathedral Commons Parking Garage, 3710 Newark Street NW (space is plentiful! Credit card payment is required. Expect to pay \$15 for 2-3 hours parking. Garage closes at 11 p.m. Board the trolley shuttle at the intersection of 38th and Macomb Streets NW starting at about 6:15 pm, or walk one block down.)

TICKETS AND SEATING

Seating is by section; individual seats are not assigned. Please check the color of your ticket for your section.

Premium (Reserved) Section (blue):	Center floor level on either side of center aisle	\$40 each
General Admission (white):	Floor level several rows behind the cross aisle	\$20 each
Seniors & Students (green):	Front of the general admission section	\$10 each

Additional tickets will be available for purchase on the evening of the concert at our box office in the Kreeger foyer of Washington Hebrew Congregation.

PATRONS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS

Special amplification for the hearing impaired is available for all seating sections. Please see ushers for audio devices.

The main entrance to Washington Hebrew Congregation is wheelchair accessible, but the parking lot entrance has limited accessibility via chair. Restrooms for persons with disabilities are located in the hallway to the right of the main entrance. Public transportation and the trolley shuttles to Washington Hebrew Congregation are also accessible. *See directions on the reverse.*

Public Transportation

Take the Metro Red Line to Tenleytown / AU. From the station, find your way to the block just down from Wisconsin Avenue NW on Ablemarle Street NW where the American University shuttles and Metro buses load. There will also be an orange and green Old Town Trolley shuttle boarding outside the Wawa convenience store there to take you directly to Washington Hebrew Congregation for free! Vehicles are accessible.

*If you prefer Metrobus from downtown, take the N2-4-6 buses from Dupont Circle
(Massachusetts Avenue & 20th St. NW)*

You will disembark at Macomb Street and Massachusetts Avenue NW. Walk east on Macomb Street until you see Washington Hebrew Congregation on the left side of Macomb Street NW.

Or take any northbound **Metrobus 30s series route** from *Farragut West, Farragut North, L'Enfant Plaza, or Foggy Bottom*. www.metroopensdoors.com for more info. Metro is accessible.

Exit nearest Macomb Street and Wisconsin Avenue NW. Walk west on Macomb Street until you see Washington Hebrew Congregation on the right before the intersection of Macomb and Mass Ave.

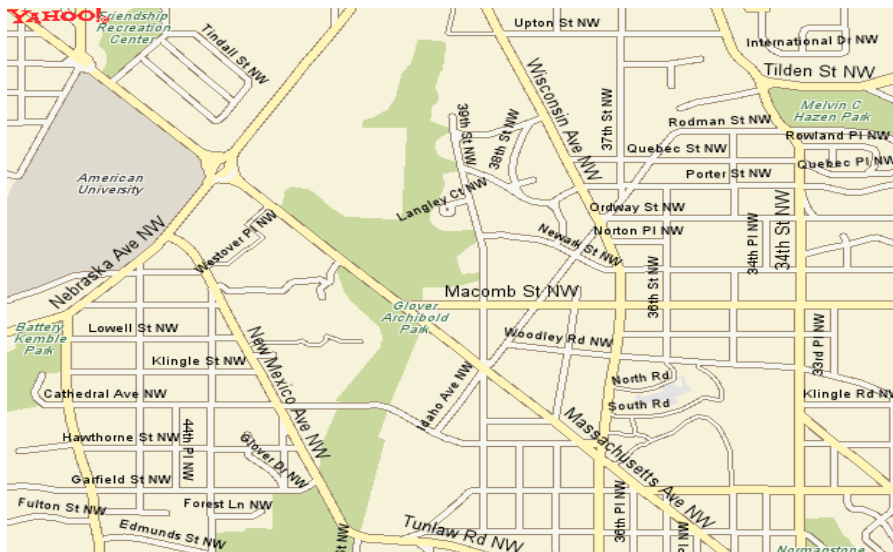
Driving Directions

From Downtown DC: Traveling on Massachusetts Avenue northbound, cross 39th street and make the next right at Macomb Street. The Temple is located on the left close to the corner of Massachusetts Avenue and 39th Street NW.

From the 495 Beltway, Montgomery County, MD: Take Wisconsin Avenue South, towards Chevy Chase/Downtown, DC. Proceed past the Mazza Gallerie (to your right at the District line) and Sidwell Friends School (further down on the left). Several blocks after Sidwell Friends, take a right onto Macomb Street - Cactus Cantina Restaurant is there on the corner of Wisconsin and Macomb. Proceed through two stop signs and the Temple will be on the right side.

From Northern Virginia / Reagan National Airport: Go straight toward Airport Exit/I-395/GW Parkway North/US-50 W/I-66/Washington. Take the US-50 W exit on the left toward Memorial Bridge/Arlington Cemetery. Take the ramp toward US-50 W/Key BRDG/Roslyn/US Marine Corps Memorial/Netherlands Carillon. Merge onto US-50 W/Arlington Blvd via the ramp on the left toward US-50 W/Roslyn Key Bridge/US-1 (crossing into Virginia). Take the ramp toward Roslyn. Turn right onto N Lynn St. Cross Key Bridge into Washington, D.C. and turn right onto M St NW. Turn left onto 33rd Street NW, right on Prospect Street NW and left on Wisconsin Ave NW. Turn left onto Cathedral Ave NW. Turn slight right onto Massachusetts Ave NW. From Massachusetts Avenue take a right onto Macomb Street NW. The Temple is located close to the corner of Massachusetts Avenue and 39th Street NW.

Free off-street parking is available at National United Methodist Church and Annunciation Catholic Church as described on the front. Paid parking is available at the Cathedral Commons Parking Garage, 3710 Newark Street NW.
