CUAH is a non-profit, non-partisan organization that unites our diverse community to combat bigotry, support victims of hate, and promote inclusiveness in Montgomery County, Maryland.

CUAH is a NETWORK of individuals and organizations who:

- **Increase support** for the programs, activities, trainings, ideas, and other initiatives of groups that serve individuals and communities affected by hate and discrimination.
- **Maintain an online and social media hub** (website, blog, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram) that includes an intake system for reporting hate incidents, directs victims to law enforcement agencies, victim services and community support groups, maintains a calendar of upcoming events organized by groups that fight hate and discrimination, publishes a blog on addressing hate and discrimination, and disseminates action alerts, a news feed, and resource materials.
- **Organize regular public meetings and forums throughout the County** that support efforts to fight discrimination and hate by recruiting and training volunteers, engaging in advocacy, organizing supporters, hosting workshops, and educating the public.
- **Organize effective community-wide rapid response to hate incidents**, including vigils, rallies, and protests, and strong responses in traditional and social media.
- **Push for programmatic reforms**, curricula improvements, and student action within the schools to address hate and bigotry.
- **Advocate for public policies and programs** at the local, state and federal level to address hate and discrimination.
